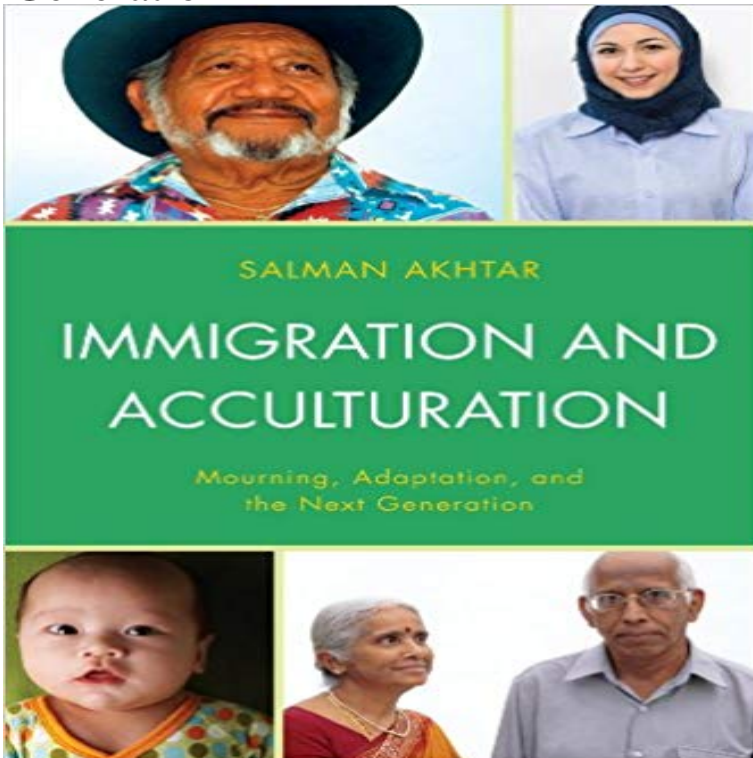


Immigration and Acculturation: Mourning, Adaptation, and the Next Generation
