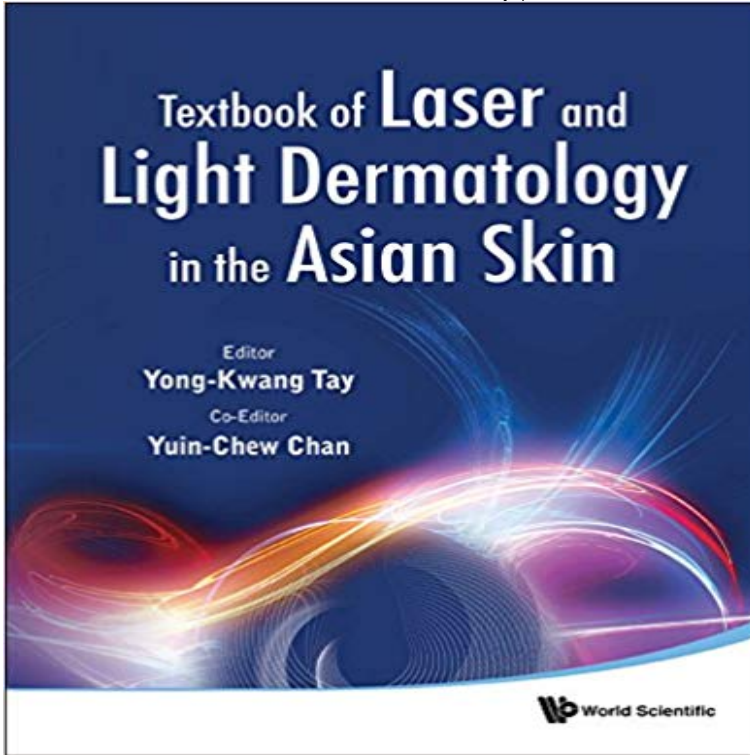


Textbook of Laser and Light Dermatology in the Asian Skin
