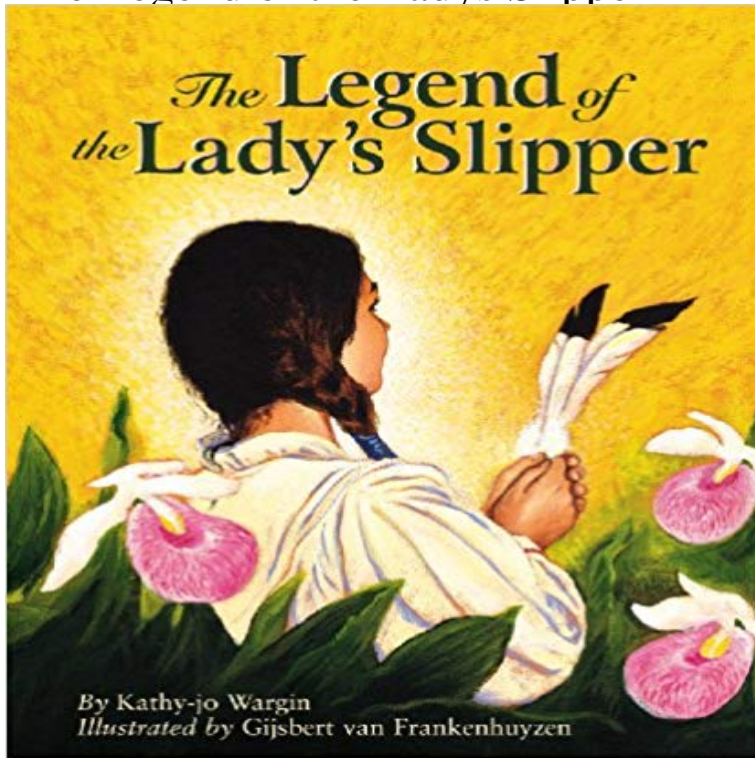


The Legend of the Ladys Slipper
