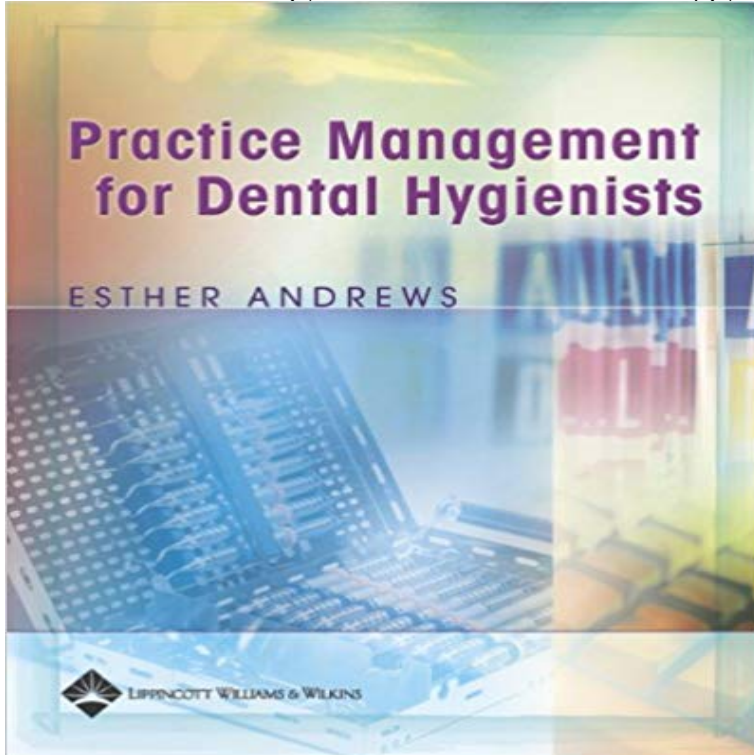


Practice Management for Dental Hygienists
